
Midget Autos to Race Saturday



Skillful young drivers will maneuver their midget automobiles in a quarter-midget race on Northgate's track Saturday. Time

trials will begin at 12:30 o'clock. The main event will be at 1.30 o'clock. The track was established three years ago.

Midget automobiles will race Saturday afternoon in the southwest corner of the Northgate parking lot. Drivers from 4 to 15 years of age will participate.

Time trials are scheduled for 12:30 o'clock in the afternoon and the main event will begin at 1:30 o'clock. There will be pit inspection of the cars during the afternoon.

A special feature of the races will be the appearance of the Thunderbird Drum and Bugle Corps. This group holds the Seafair Grand Award in the Junior Division and consists of 50 talented musicians aged from 12 to 14 years old.

Quarter-midget is the name given to the small racing automobiles because they are about one fourth the size of regular racing cars. Some of the young racers make their own autos, using do-it-yourself kits. Others are priced as high as \$400 ready-made. Most of the racers are owned by the children's parents.
