





#### Motion #1 from the Floor

#### Current wording from Chapter 9 - Flagging Procedure

After the warm up time has expired, the yellow flag should be displayed for at least one (1) lap before the line up signal is given. The original line up signal should be a rolled yellow and a rolled green, (1 in each hand) displayed in a drumming motion. A "one to go" pointed green flag may be used.

#### Proposed Wording

After the warm up time has expired, the yellow flag should be displayed for at least one (1) lap before the line up signal is given. The initial line up signal will be a single rolled yellow flag. All cars will at this time move into a numerical single file lineup, as determined by the tower. Once completed the flagman will signal drivers with a rolled yellow and rolled green flag, one in each hand, displayed in a drumming motion signaling for cars to move into a double file starting lineup. Cars will then move into their designated start positions. Once completed the flagman may use a "one to go" pointed green flag to alert drivers of the impending start of the race.

The only cars that may be entered and run in two classes are "AA" and <u>"World Formula"</u> as a "1/2" class car.
- 1. E The "1/2" class is defined by separate dimensions and is not the same as the quarter midget class. If one car and engine is run as an "AA," <u>"World formula"</u> or "1/2" it must meet the wheelbase and wheel tread width of the respective classes.


