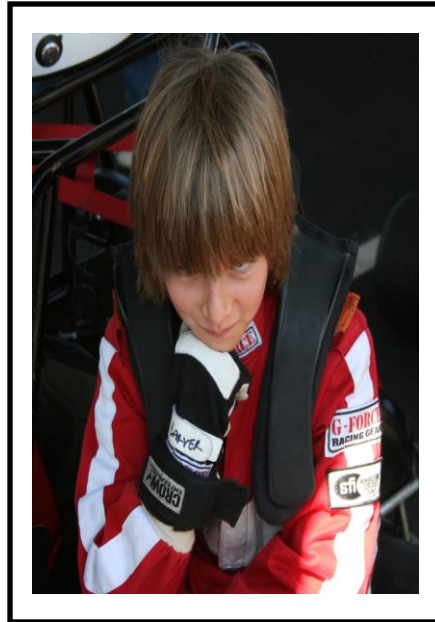

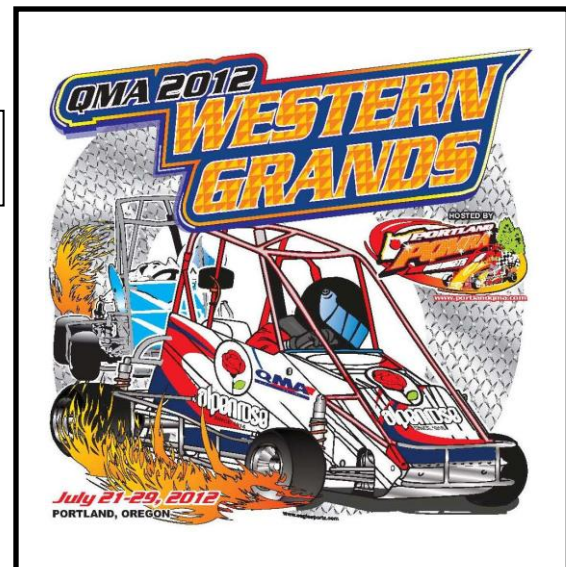

Today is qualifying day: the hardest day of the week. Please make sure before you go out to qualify you check your tread width, nerf bars, transponder location: any items that will result in a DQ.

Throughout the practice rounds Tech has been at the scales to look over your cars to insure that they meet all specifications. Any issues that were brought to your attention should have been taken care before you cross the scales today. In addition to the tech inspections on the car itself, safety items will also be checked.

It is ultimately the handler's responsibility to make sure that seals for fueling and motor are done properly. Also, remember to make sure that your qualifying number is painted on the engine and the frame. Don't be afraid to ask any officials for help at any time.
